Position Descriptions:

The **Treasurer** serves a three (3) year term. They are responsible for the administration of the finances of SLACA, subject to budgetary and other regulations approved by the Executive Committee and the Association.

The **Councilor** (**prizes and awards**) serves a three (3) year term. Councilors shall attend the meetings and participate in the business of the Committee. The prizes and award councilor oversees the awarding of two paper prizes and one book prize.

The **Councilor** (**program**) serves a three (3) year term. Councilors shall attend the meetings and participate in the business of the Committee. The program councilor is responsible for evaluating the SLACA submissions for the AAA annual meeting.

The **Councilor** (**Anthropology News column**) serves a three (3) year term. Councilors shall attend the meetings and participate in the business of the Committee. The Anthropology News column councilor is responsible for soliciting columns for publication in Anthropology News.

The **Councilor (Website)** serves a three (3) year term. Councilors shall attend the meetings and participate in the business of the Committee. The website councilor is responsible for updating and maintaining the SLACA website.

The **Student Councilor** serves three (3) years or until termination of student status, whichever comes first. Councilors shall attend the meetings and participate in the business of the Committee, serve on such subcommittees as may be established, and take on special assignments.

Full Name (First & Last) Education (highest degree earned, institution where degree was earned, year degree was earned) **Positions Held:** (Limit 5 -most recent first): Title, (dates from-to) Name of Institution; **Interests and/or Activities:** (Limit 3); **Significant Publications:** (Limit 3 – most recent first): Title, co-authors/editors if applicable, where published, year published.

The platform statement should be approximately 200 words in length. Statements significantly over 200 words will be cut down to 200 words before publishing.
